



## Hello, Ruby Roubaix friends!

Some of you have already reserved your space with a \$40 deposit for the Lion's Camp Lamoille "2025, Ruby Roubaix Camping Experience." If you are one of these, ignore this notice.

**The Special 2025 Camping Offer\* will end when full. Reservation deadline is June 10, 2025.**

- This Ruby Roubaix exclusive camping experience is not open to the public. A maximum of 150 individual overnight guests are allowed, regardless of group composition.
- There are 5 options, based on first-come first serve:
  - 2 quantity 10-person cabins with 5, 2-person bunks in each
  - 3 quantity 5-person cabins with no furnishings (good for staying under a roof, though you will need to bring your own sleeping bags/cots/bed pads, etc.)
  - 3 quantity 6-8 person enclosed A-frames with no furnishings (good for staying under a roof, though you will need to provide your own sleeping bags/cots/bed pads, etc.)
  - 12 quantity RV sites with full hook-ups
  - Nearly unlimited space to pitch tents on the grass field
- Each of these options is \$110 for your party - this is not per person - for the **whole weekend** - held with a non-refundable deposit which will be deducted from the billed balance owed in the month of June, prior to the event date.
- There are no extra fees. The cost is all-inclusive, whether you dry camp, reserve a cabin, or reserve a spot for your camper with power and water hookups. (large campers and equipment trailers will fit) **Fill out this form** and secure your reservation.
- The deposit will be refunded to you if we do not secure the minimum number of camping (spot) commitments to cover our costs of renting the venue, or if we must cancel the the cycling event. (we don't anticipate this issue.)
- Arrive as early as 1:00 P.M. on Friday, June 27, 2025, and depart no later than noon on Sunday, June 29, 2025.
- Our club will NOT offer or manage any other camping arrangements over the 2025 weekend. We aren't trying to be inhospitable, but the 50th annual Lamoille Fair (see 2024 49th Annual Country Fair | Facebook) is also scheduled for Sunday, June 29, 2025. Camping and parking in - and everywhere around Lamoille - will be scarce.
- For those want a ride back up the canyon after their event...we will provide shuttling.

## Camping Assets

- Three unfurnished A-frame, rustic cabins with power, lights, wood floor, and tip-up ventilation windows. Each cabin sleeps up to 8.
- Twelve RV spaces with power and water hookups
- Plenty of space for tents and dry camping
- Men's and women's showers, a pavilion that covers a BBQ grill, picnic tables with seating for 80, a volleyball court, an athletic field, and horseshoe pits. Includes a backup generator, access to trails, and spectacular views of Lamoille Canyon from your camp.
- Two Bully Barn cabins with 5 bunk beds in each One Bully Barn cabin - no furniture One cabin structure- no furniture 15' x 20' with power and lighting in all" to "Three Bully Barn cabins - no furniture . 15' x 20' with power and lighting in all five.



## Pricing Details

The special camping offer for 2025 Camp Lamoille is \$110 until camp capacity is full or until June 10, 2025.

It is offered exclusively to registered riders and their guests. It is not open to the general public, so it's a Ruby Roubaix camping experience.

Camp is located just 6.6 miles from the Start and Finish Line in front of the Lamoille Schoolhouse.

A stream runs directly behind the pavilion.
