Overnight parking will not be permitted for cyclists within Lamoille this year. Please plan accordingly and make alternative arrangements if needed.

The BIG Loop - Heads Up

The 120.5 mile Ruby Loop ride begins and ends in scenic Lamoille along the west flank of the Ruby Mountains, with the highest range peaks dominating the eastern skyline as you head south toward Lee (Lee Peak, Mount Gilbert, and Ruby Dome (11,392')) and the headwaters of the South Fork of the Humboldt River. Depending on the winter-spring snowpack, you may encounter a couple of water crossings along this section. From Lee, you will enter into one of the most challenging parts of the ride. At mile 22, you will come off a gravel road at Woods Lane, cross over a paved highway, and enter onto a dirt/bug dust (loose fine dirt) two-track road that presents significant challenges due to large washouts and deep ruts. Riders should be especially cautious in this area, as the terrain can be unpredictable and difficult to navigate. It's crucial to slow down and

maintain control to avoid accidents or damage to the bike or other persons. Everyone should be mindful of their surroundings and ride with extra care through this approximately 4.5- mile portion of the Ruby Loop.
