



Registration Information

- Online registration closes at midnight **TOMORROW NIGHT** June 17th
 - Manual registration and packet pickup is open from 2:00 PM until 7:00 PM on Friday, June 21st.
 - Last-minute registrations and packet pickup will be open from 5:00 AM to 6:00 AM on race day.
- PLEASE AVOID** waiting until the last minute to sign up!

Important Notes

- Day parking is available at the Lamoille Schoolhouse (no overnight parking)
- All riders are required to sign a photo release and liability waiver. If you are under the age of 18 years, you must secure a signature from your parent or legal guardian on the day you sign your waiver. These waivers are part of your online registration questions.
- There will be clothing drop boxes at each aid station. Your items will be bagged with your bib number written on the outside of it and


returned to the schoolhouse when the aid station shuts down. If you can not pick up your clothing by the end of the event, consider recruiting a friend to collect it for you. Anything left unclaimed at the schoolhouse will be donated to the local thrift store.

· If you decide to leave the course before finishing the ride, please report to the timer at the schoolhouse, let the SAG team on your route know, or call 775-389-1862 as soon as possible to let us know you will not finish and are safe. We will need your bib number and name.


· A map of the 4 different loop routes will be posted at the schoolhouse, with information about Aid Stations, what is available there, their locations, and the distances between each one.



Start Times



Start times are as follows:
Line up 15 minutes early to receive updates on cattle drives, event traffic (where applicable), loose gravel, washouts, etc.
Men and Women on Ruby Loop - start at 6:30 AM
Men, Women, e-bikes, on Secret Pass - start at 7:00 AM
Men, Women, e-bikes on Lee Loop and Pleasant Valley Loop - start at 7:30 AM



Items to make note of

· Riders on the following loops must have made it to the aid stations identified below by 11:00 AM or will be picked up by the SAG team and returned to the schoolhouse:

- Ruby Loop - must make it to Harrison Pass Aid Station by 11:00 AM
- Secret Pass - must make it to the Ruby Valley Aid Station by

11:00 AM

o Pleasant Valley and Lee - must make it as far as the Pleasant Valley / Chimney Creek Road by 11:00 AM

· Each aid station and SAG truck will have a scant collection of tools, a tire pump, and bike tire tubes. Be as prepared as possible and carry your own and handle your own repairs whenever possible.

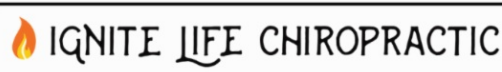
